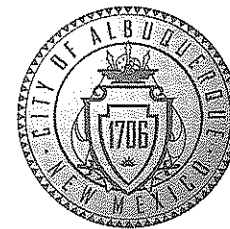



Based on the results of this election AFSCME and Local 624 Transit are hereby given notice that as of October 8, 2011, AFSCME will no longer be recognized by the City as the exclusive representative for the City of Albuquerque Motor Coach Operators and Van Chauffeurs. Union membership payroll dues deductions for these employees will be terminated on the same date.

Also, as a result of the September 14, 2011, representation election, this letter serves to document the certification of the New Mexico Transportation Union as the Exclusive Representative for the City of Albuquerque Transit Motor Coach Operators and Van Chauffeurs. This certification is effective October 8, 2011.
